OPEN CLASS NEEDLEWORK DEPARTMENT

1. Entry article must have been made by the exhibitor him/herself, and entered under the maker's true name. If the superintendent has any doubt, he/she may determine the entering of the article.
2. Entry must not have been entered in the county competition in any previous year. If superintendent has any doubt, he/she may determine the entering of the article.
3. The superintendent shall determine if the entry is to be exhibited in the Needlework Department or another department.
4. Entry must have been made by a Cass County resident only.
5. All articles must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
6. Only one article per person per class/lot is permitted.
7. In case there is but a single entry in a class, the Judge shall determine the merit of a prize.
8. Management will NOT be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to exhibits while on display. But the usual precautions for safety of all exhibits will be taken.
9. Management will NOT be responsible for articles not picked up within a reasonable amount of time after release time. It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to make every effort to pick up his/her articles at release time.
